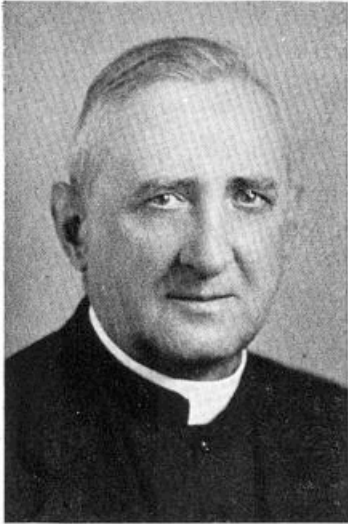

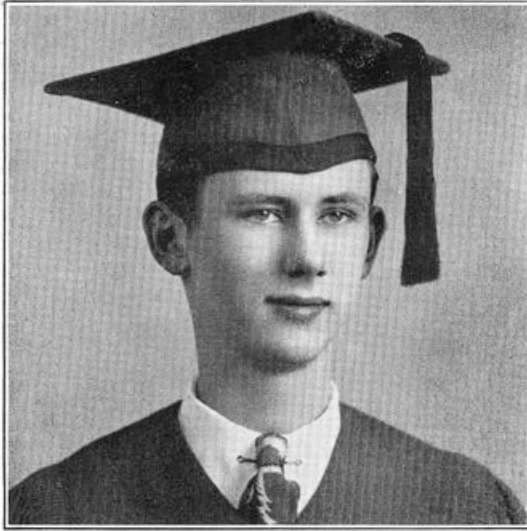
We submit this CASMIRECHO as a resume' of our four years at St. Casimir High School, hoping that it brings many delightful reminiscences in another day.

The characters and incidents full of helter-skelter fun and spontaneous laughter, held the audience in spellbound entertainment for two and a half hours.



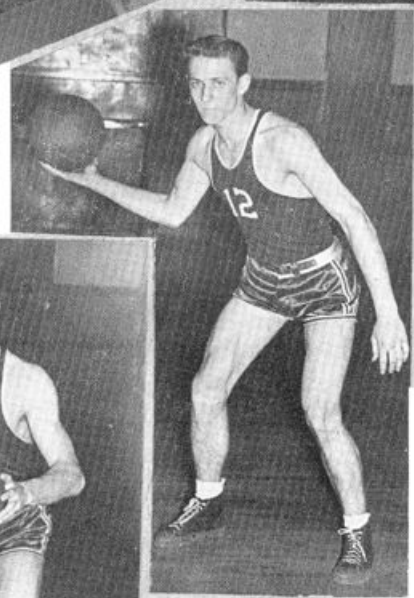

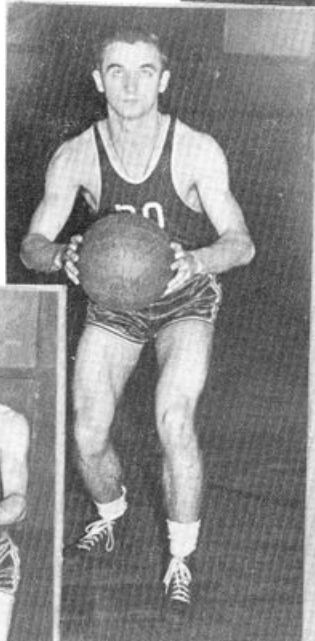
