



Home of the Season (HOTS) Committee

Home of the Season is an idea that began with the Association many years ago. It was revived in 1988 when ORGHA was re-activated. The motivation for the Committee is to encourage residents to maintain their homes and enhance the neighborhood. It also provides public recognition for the hard work that so many of us put into our homes and gardens.

Under the current procedures, judging is done four times a year. Judges cannot *nominate* a home on the street of their residence, but can participate in the final vote for any nominations made. In the event of a tie, the homes tied will be voted on again.

A plaque will be displayed on the winner's lawn and all nominated will receive a certificate suitable for framing.

Judging criteria includes:

Creativity and originality

Daytime décor

Nighttime décor

Variety

Color scheme

A home may only win once within a five year period. This implies that a winning home can only be nominated once in a five year period.

Beginning with the Spring of 2014, a home (other than a winning home) may be nominated only once in a four-season period.
