Some of you walkers might have noticed some unusual digging activity on the Mies Park asphalt pathway. Twenty years ago, Phil Johnson put in tenth mile markers along the inside of the path for his Troop 270 Eagle Scout project. They are being rejuvenated by his Dad Bruce to help walkers and joggers mark their distances. The 0 marker is along the northeast corner of the park just past the evergreens on the corner of W. Chicago and Blackburn/Delaware. There are markers for .1, .2, .3, .4, .6, and .7 which brings you back around and finally a mile marker near the south goalposts. (The half mile was close to the flagpole.) So, take notice the next time you go for a walk and you can track your mileage.

We are definitely having the Garden walk and I would like to remind folks that for the benefit of everyone you may come in contact with please wear your mask and keep the appropriate distance. We are very grateful for the folks willing to open up their yard this year. A big thank you.


